Chairman Kevin Koth called the meeting to order. Supervisors Joan Hilgendorf, John Crass and Jennifer Bishop were present.

The Treasurer's report was presented as follows: Building & Office Equipment Fund-\$160,948.96 Equipment Fund - \$250,831.14; General Savings Account - \$2,908,660.15; Checking Account - \$195,379.47; Cemetery Fund - \$70,586.58; Re-Evaluation - \$40,000.00; Capital Outlay - \$23,675.00; and Greenwood Cemetery CD - \$12,625.04; Tax Money Collected - \$2,908,597.50.
